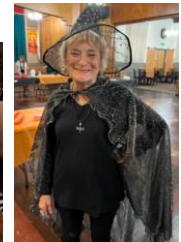
HAPPY BIRTHDAY!

VOLUNTEERING

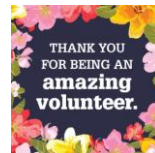
