FAT TUESDAY - On 3/4, wings & gumbo will be served from 5:30-7:00pm to celebrate Fat Tuesday.

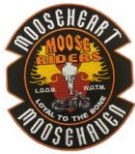


SOUP COOK OFF - What a fun night.
