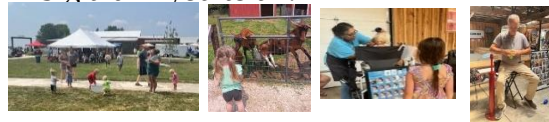

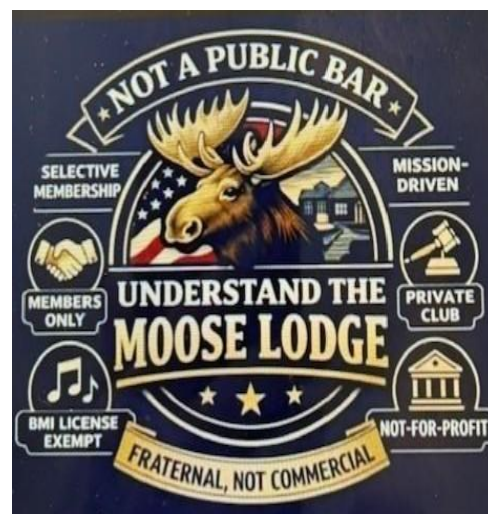

SUNDAY DRAWINGS & RAFFLES There are 3 meat raffles & 50/50 drawing every Sunday starting at 3:30pm. The Membership & Attendance Drawing is at 4:00pm. The Membership Drawing costs \$1.00 & you can sign up with the Bartender any day for the current week. The pot as of the printing of the Moose call is **\$3,140**. If you are present at the Sunday Membership Drawing, you can win 90% of the money & 50% if you are not present. Good Luck to those who enter each week.



BINGO - Join us on Wednesday nights for Bingo. We play every Wednesday night. Doors open at 4:00 pm with card sales beginning at 5:00pm. Bingo starts at 6:00pm. Kitchen is open 5:00 to 7:00pm with a weekly special. Prize money is based on the number of players that week so the more people the more prize money.

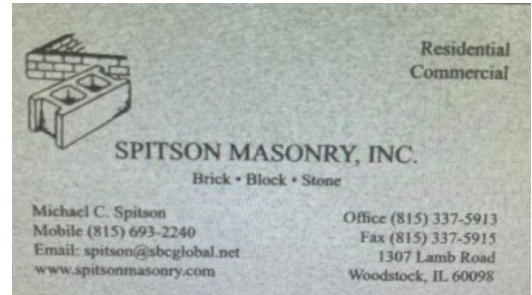

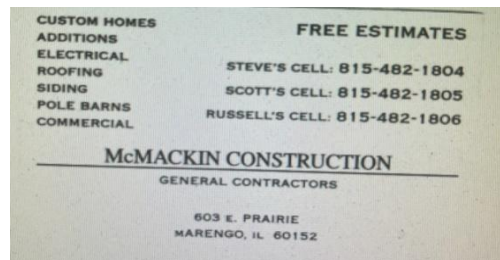
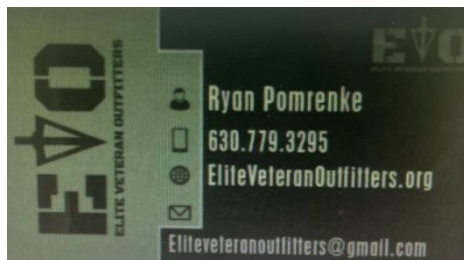
