There is a cooler with cash & lottery tickets being raffled in the Social Quarters. Profit goes to Christmas for the kids. Take a chance. It's a win for the kids.



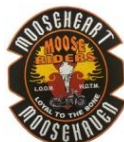

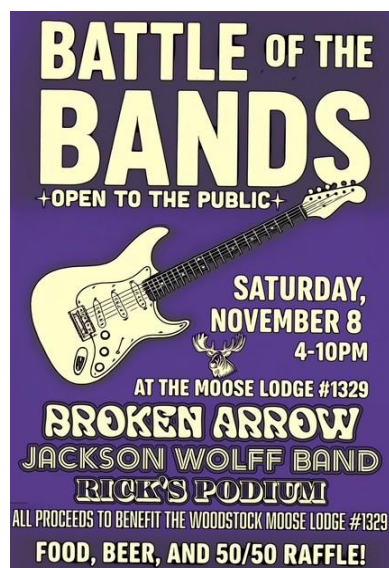

**FROM THE PRESIDENT** - There is a great Scholarship Program available through the Moose. It's the Moose Youth Awareness Scholarship Program. The Brochures are in the Lobby. Below are the requirements for the Scholarship.

### **Requirements**

1. This competition is open to U.S. & Canadian high school students who develop brief talks to deliver to groups of children 4 to 9 years of age whom they identify in their community.
2. The talks must deal with such current issues as drug & alcohol abuse, child abuse, "stranger danger," bullying & peer pressure, healthy habits & nutrition.
3. Students must make at least 3 talks in their community & submit written reports on their presentations.
4. School officials select 2 participating students to attend a local student congress; selection is based on academic ability & leadership qualities.
5. At those congresses, participants present their talks to fellow students, & 60 of them are selected by their peers to attend the International Student Congress.
6. At that Congress, participating students vote to select the winners of the scholarships.
