We collect donations for the Endowment Fund as part of the ceremony. For those of you don't know about the Endowment Fund, it is the fund that protects the continued operations of both Mooseheart and Moosehaven. Also, during the month of February we will be taking donations for the Endowment fund as part of the yearly Rocker campaign. Members are asked to donate \$1 or more through purchasing a Rocker that will be placed on the wall of the lodge. Please help us raise as much money for this vital fund.

Our Grant was Denied

Last June Moose International announced a "Lodge Improvement Grant Program". They were going to allocate \$1,000,000 per year for the next 3 years toward this program. The maximum grant would be \$25,000 per Lodge. Last Fall we applied for the full \$25,000 to go toward a new roof, with our Lodge contributing the balance. It turned out they received requests totaling over \$17,000,000 from over 750 Lodges. What an overwhelming need. They did grant over \$1,000,000 to 106 Lodges. Unfortunately our Lodge wasn't included. They promised to give full details later in the Moose Magazine and eventually on the website.

There are still two more years to go in the program, and we will apply each year. We can no longer wait on the roof, so we plan to replace it this Spring. At the March 5th Special L.O.O.M. meeting, we plan to present our most pressing projects for approval.
