## A CENTURY OF MOOSE

We will soon celebrate our 100th year of Moosedom - wow what a great achievement and many thanks to all of you past and present members for your membership and volunteerism. The Woodstock Moose lodge was founded on January 25, 1918, with a total of 54 members on the original charter, by the year 1928 the lodge had increased to over 400 members, with a women's chapter being initiated on January 14th, 1920 with 30 charter members. The men have a present day total of over 1100 and the women are over 800 members strong. In the beginning the lodge held their meetings at the Viking Hall located on the south side of the Woodstock square and later at the Waverly House on Main Street. In 1947 the property at Clay and Hutchinson street was purchased with a ground breaking ceremony for the new lodge home in November of 1950, the building was completed and dedicated on June 15th, 1952. The dining room area and north side of the building were dedicated on October 20, 1957, making the building almost 20,000 square feet of floor space on two levels. Both lots where the lodge is located originally consisted of a two story home and a laundry service building. In the upcoming Moose Calls there will be more history and a picture or two depicting the old and the new buildings, along with plans for the 100th year celebration.
