MEMBERS AND "QUALIFIED" GUESTS

Because our Lodge is a 501c-8 organization, we receive special tax treatment. In order to keep our tax status we must conform to our chartered

standards. We are a private fraternal organization. Because we support MooseHeart, MooseHaven and our local community charities, the government waives certain income tax requirements. If we fail to abide by our fraternal rules, the IRS can vacate our tax privilege status and go back ten years and require us to pay taxes and penalties for late payments. This very thing happened recently to a lodge in Wisconsin when they served a non-member.

Only members in good standing may make purchases and participate in our activities. A member may bring in a guest, but only under certain conditions. Guests are not allowed to make any purchases or play video gaming, pull tabs, lightning, etc. When a member brings in a guest, the guest should sign in the guest book. A guest may only visit our lodge twice. Children under 21 and spouses of members are exempt from the 2 visit rule.

When guest applies for membership, they are not a member until their application is approved at a board meeting and may not purchase or participate in social quarter activities. During the application period, the prospective member may visit the lodge as frequently as they want, as long as they are accompanied by their sponsor.
