Quilts have long been used to tell a story and the one looking over the Lodge dance floor does just that. This quilt tells the story of Wally Hitzeman (Wally), and his legacy of service. Wally was dedicated—not just to his wife, daughter, and granddaughters, but to lodge and community as a whole. Wally wanted nothing more than to help a fellow person, whether it be through encouragement to be the best version of themselves, empathy during a tough time, or simply to make them laugh. This quilt represents exactly that. Wally's investment and passion for his lodge and community inspired his loving wife PeeWee to find a way to tell that story. She spent countless hours hand drawing the emblems of each office held by the men and women of the Moose Lodge. Years later, their dream came to fruition with the help of Sally Slack's talented sewing skills used to loom each of those drawings onto the quilt. Sadly, Wally passed a few years before he could see this stunning piece of art, but his legacy lives on. The quilt embodies the story of a man, a family, a team, and a lodge of dedicated individuals who came together with the same mission: to care for all, bring communities together, and celebrate life.




## WE WANT YOUR <u>FEEDBACK</u>
